### **P (UK) BEBO JUNIOR/INTERMEDIATE RIDDEN M&M WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge: Mrs. E. Payne**

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered in their respective Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders for Small Breeds not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> Birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Riders for Large Breeds not to have attained their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 1.** Mixed M&M Small Breeds – Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B

**Class 2.** Mixed M&M Large Breeds – Not exceeding 138 cms.

**Class 3.** Mixed M&M Large Breeds – Exceeding 138 cms

### **NPS JUNIOR RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

This competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, there are no specific registration criteria.

**Class 4** Ponies not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**Class 5** Ponies exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

### **NPS/CHECKLEYBANK M&M NOVICE LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P (UK) CONFINED NOVICE COLNE M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Leading Rein class. To be shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein must be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year).

**Class 6.** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exc. 122cms.

### **NPS M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP P (UK) CONFINED NOVICE WAXWING M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**Judge: Mrs L.Ahmet**

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any First Ridden class. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year).

**Class 7.** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exc. 128cms.

### **NPS / T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP P (UK) COLNE M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge : Mrs L.Ahmet**

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands.

Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year).

**Class 8.** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exc. 122cms.

**NPS / KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P (UK) WAXWING M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge: Mrs L.Ahmet**

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> but not have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday (riders' ages are as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year).

**Class 9.** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exc. 128cms.

**NPS / HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.**

**Judge: Mrs L.Ahmet**

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bridles. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

**Class 10.** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

**Class 11.** Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D

**P (UK) CHESHAM HANDLER WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge : Mrs K. Lloyd**

All handler classes are to be judged on the handlers presentation and showing technique.

**Class 12** Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms, to be led by a handler who has attained their 7<sup>th</sup> birthday but has not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

**Class 13.** Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cms, to be led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

**NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER & P(UK) CONFINED NOVICE LLANARTH M&M RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.**

**Judge: Mrs L.Ahmet**

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

**Class 14.** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

**Class 15.** Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

**NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP & P (UK) LLANARTH M&M RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge : Mrs L.Ahmet**

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

**Class 16** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B

**Class 17** Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D

**NPS/The Minns M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS member in the M&M Ridden section.

### NPS/LEYHILLS M&M IN-HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Judge: Mrs L.Ahmet

This Competition is open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Handler any age except for stallions or colts where the handler must be 14 years of age or older.

- Class 18 Small Breeds, Yearling, 2 and 3 years old Colt, Filly or Gelding.
- Class 19 Small Breeds, 4 years and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding.
- Class 20 Large Breeds, Yearling, 2 and 3 years old Colt, Filly or Gelding.
- Class 21 Large Breeds, 4 years and over, Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

### NPS / Kilmannan Stud M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS member in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card.

### P (UK) KESTON ROYAL OCCASION M&M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Judge: Miss. J.Paterson

**Class 22.** Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Yearling Colt, Filly or Gelding, Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest and Welsh A, B, C, or D.

*N.B. Shows holding Foal Classes before 31<sup>st</sup> December may award qualifiers for the Keston Royal Occasion M&M In Hand Yearling Championship*

*Three Year olds qualifying before the 31st December 2011 will qualify for the senior 4 years old and over Winter Championship of their Respective Breeds.*

**Class 23.** Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Colt, Filly or Gelding, 2 or 3 years old. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest and Welsh A, B, C or D.

**Class 24.** Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, and Welsh Section A and B.

**Class 25.** Mixed Mountain and Moorland In Hand Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C and D.

### P (UK) CONFINED NOVICE KESTON ROYAL OCCASION M&M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPION.

Judge: Miss J.Paterson

**Class 26.** Mixed Mountain & Moorland In Hand Stallion, Colt, Filly, Mare or Gelding, any age. To be shown in hand. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland & Welsh Section A or B. NOT to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open mixed M&M In Hand classification before 1st January in the current year.

**Class 27.** Mixed Mountain & Moorland In Hand Stallion, Colt, Filly, Mare or Gelding, any age. To be shown in hand. Registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C or D. NOT to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open mixed M&M In Hand classification before 1st January in the current year.

**P(UK) MIRAGE SHOW HUNTER PONY WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge: Mrs E. Payne**

**Class 28.** PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

**Class 29.** PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 143 cms. Ponies not exc133 cm riders not to have attained their 14th birthday, ponies up to 143cms riders not to have attained their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday in the current year.

**Class 30.** SHOW HUNTER TYPE, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

**P (UK) SPRINGFIELD PART BRED RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

**Judge: Mrs E. Payne**

Exhibits to be registered in the Part Bred section of their Breed Society, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over, any height, rider any age.

**Class 31.** Registered Part Bred Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years and over not exc. 148cms Rider any age.

**Class 32.** Registered Part Bred Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years and over exceeding 148cms. Rider any age.

**P (UK) WATSON RIDDEN COMPETITION/DRESSAGE HORSE/PONY WINTER CHAMP.**

**Judge: Mrs E. Payne**

Competition/Dressage Horse Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, any height.

Method of Judging; - Horses and Ponies to enter the ring individually and will not be ridden by the Judge and will be judged according to the P(UK) Performance / Competition Class Rules

Phase 1	Performance & Freestyle Show	60 Marks
Phase 2	Conformation, Type & Suitability for Dressage	40 Marks

The individual Freestyle Show to include the following movements in an arena no larger than 40m x 60m. Halt, walk on a long rein, ordinary trot serpentine, extended trot on the diagonal, canter serpentine with change of lead, extended canter on the diagonal. *Not to Exceed 2 mins.*

**Class 33** Competition Horse, Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148 cms, Riders any age.

**Class 34.** Competition Pony, Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148 cms, Riders any age.

**Class 35. P (UK) AMATEUR RIDERS RIDING PONY WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153 cms. Riders any age.

**Class 36. Unaffiliated Mixed Height Novice Ridden.**

**Judge: Mrs K. Lloyd**

Any type of pony/horse. Open to all breeds, part breds etc. 4 years old & over. Rider any age.

Cantering in individual show ONLY. Ponies not to have won a first in any open class.

**Class 37. Unaffiliated Amateur Adults.**

This class is aimed at riders aged 40+ returning or new to the show ring. Any suitable horse or pony. It is expected that exhibitors will enter into the true spirit of this class.

Classes may be split if sufficient entries.

Classes 36 & 37 to be judged in the first available ring.

## NPS AREA 13 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 LIABILITY Neither the organisers of the event, nor the NPS nor any agent employee or riders accept liability for any loss damage injury or illness to ponies owners riders spectators or property caused by negligence breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The organisers will expect all exhibitors to have third party insurance for their animals
- 2 The judge's decision is final. The committee reserve the right to substitute judges in case of unavailability. Please call the show secretary should you wish to check any judge changes.
- 3 The organisers may divide or amalgamate classes according to entries, and reserve the right to refuse entry
- 4 The organisers strongly recommend exhibitors to enter by the closing date, to enable timetable changes to be made and those exhibitors notified
- 5 No spurs allowed. Whips and canes must not exceed an overall length of 30 inches and must be of plain leather covered. Please make sure you are certain of each individual society rules.
- 6 Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered in their respective Breed Society Stud Book. Please give reg. No's on entry form as you entry will be returned if the form is not complete
- 7 All stallions and colts 2 years old or over must be in possession of a current stallion licence unless otherwise governed by their official breed society
- 8 Inevitably some exhibitors classes will clash whilst stewards will try to accommodate you **NO CLASS WILL BE HELD UP FOR A SINGLE COMPETITOR**
- 9 The organisers will expect all exhibitors to have read these rules and to abide by them. Should a complaint be made, it must be accompanied by the name and address of the complainant (in writing) together with the sum of £25-00. This is non refundable if the complaint is upheld by the committee
- 10 All dogs must be kept on leads.

### NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Full members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2012.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2011/2012 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2012 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2012.

### P(UK) Winter Championship Show.

This show is a qualifier for the 2012 P (UK) Winter Championship Show. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each qualifying class will qualify. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are not current members of P (UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. No Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.
